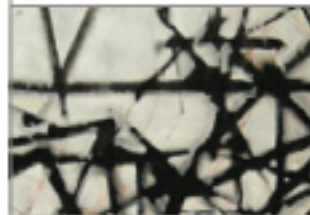

THE ART DICTIONARY

Giclée (pronounced "zhee-clay"): the process of making fine art prints from a digital source using ink-jet printing. The word "giclée" is derived from the French language word "le gicleur" meaning "nozzle", or more specifically "gicler" meaning "to squirt, spurt, or spray". They are printed onto the best media substrates including canvas, fine art papers, and photo-base papers.
